<u>Lost Property</u>

We have a considerable amount of lost property in school – probably more than we have ever had at this time of year. All of it is unnamed – most of it looks brand new. Any uniform that did not have the school logo on went in the bags to school collection. If you are missing items then please speak to either Mrs Davies or Mrs Griffin about looking through the pile to see if an belongs to your child. Recently there have been some parents who have been somewhat rude to staff regarding their child's 'lost' clothing and that is simply not acceptable. Please DO NOT take up staff's valuable time before and after school about missing uniform. As has been said previously, it is not our job to look after and locate your child/ren's clothes, neither is it our fault if your child's clothing is lost. Quite often, it is where your child has left it – on the field, on the fence, on their peg, on their chair or even on the floor. If it has their name on it, then it will get back to them, if not... it goes in the lost property pile of doom. It has been a long time since I have had to buy school uniform for my own children, but I am guessing it is still not cheap; therefore, spending time over half term, naming your child/ren's clothing (biro will do, just check it is still there after the item has been washed) and teaching your child the importance of independence and looking after their own belongings, would indeed be time well spent.

Please remember for PE days your child/ren will need to have a full PE kit, in a bag, in school. This should include

- black shorts/trackie bottoms/running tights (<u>please avoid casual leggings</u>, they are not suitable for PE)
- black school PE T-shirt,
- jumper preferably a school hoodie,
- trainers.

PE takes place outdoors regardless of the weather, so as we move further into the Autumn term – trackies and a hoodie are essential to keep your child warm and comfortable.

Please see below for our PE timetable for the first Autumn term.

As always, if you are sending your child/ren into school wearing PE trainers with laces, they are expected to be able to tie them – even when they are in KS1. If your child struggles with this, can I please politely ask that you invest time to teach them how to tie their laces – it is really not our job to do it and untied laces are just an accident waiting to happen. Very reasonably priced children's trainers with Velcro fastenings can also be purchased from Tesco (and other supermarket retailers or Sports Direct) if your child is finding tying shoe laces challenging, then do not send them into school with shoes with laces in.

We ask that PE kits stay in school all week — or even better, for the whole half term. That way, children are always ready for PE, even if we have to make a last-minute change to the timetable.

School Dinner Payments

After half term, a new feature will be in place on Arbor regarding school dinners. From half term onwards, school dinners can only be booked if your child's account has a positive balance as currently for several families, meal balances are being treated like an overdraft and it is only being cleared when asked to by Mrs Griffin/Davies. Please ensure that by half term, any outstanding dinner money debts are paid – there is currently approx. £160 owed in dinner money debt. After half term, ensure that your child's account is in credit if you wish them to have a school meal. If your account is not in credit, you will either need to top up their account by 9:30am or bring in a packed lunch. If no lunch is provided, a duty of care meal – a bowl of soup – will be served to your child. If there is repeated failure to either ensure dinner money is in credit or a packed lunch provided, then a referral to Social Care will be made due to concerns regarding the failure to provide adequate food for your child at lunch times. Your support with this is very much appreciated.
